### ORDER

As per Government order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, Government approved the Request for Qualification (RFQ) formulated by Vizhinjam International Seaport Limited in consultation with the Planning Commission, Government of India for selection of a Concessionaire (Developer-cum Operator) for the Vizhinjam International Deepwater Multipurpose Seaport through Public Private Partnership (PPP). Thereafter, vide Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, Government approved the shortlisting of the 5 applicants who have submitted Request for Qualification for the development of Vizhinjam International Deepwater Multipurpose Seaport Project.

Subsequently Government vide Government Order read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above approved the Request For Proposal in respect of Vizhinjam International Deepwater Multipurpose Seaport Project and authorized Vizhinjam International Seaport Limited to issue the same to the shortlisted applicants on behalf of Government of Kerala.

The Managing Director, Vizhinjam International Seaport Limited in his letter read as 4th paper above has informed that the feasibility report of the project, which is also to be issued to the shortlisted bidders along with Request For Proposal has been placed before the Empowered Committee meeting held on 25-03-2014. The Empowered Committee after discussion, approved the Feasibility Report and recommended the same to Government of Kerala for approval. Accordingly, Managing Director, Vizhinjam International Seaport Limited has forwarded the feasibility report and requested Government to approve the same for issuing to the shortlisted bidders along with Request For Proposal.

Gove have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to approve the feasibility report for the development of Vizhinjam International Deepwater Multipurpose Seaport Project and also authorize Vizhinjam International Seaport Limited to issue the same to the shortlisted applicants along with Request For Proposal on behalf of Government of Kerala.
